PENTECOST What is it that blinds me to the reality of what I read about Pentecost? What makes me refuse to acknowledge that it can happen to me just as it did to the Apostles? That, within my unworthy self, there is a temple in which the Spirit adores without easing? Lord, is it a fear that, by accepting your greatness at the centre of myself, great things will be asked of me? Is it possible that, in my desire to avoid pain, I also deprive myself of experiencing joy? The risen Jesus penetrates the disciples' defences, overcomes their fears, and brings them joy. I ask him to pass through all my security systems and liberate me from whatever

prevents me from 'having life and having it in all its fullness'.

Jesus always brings peace and reconciliation. Saint Augustine called peace 'the tranquillity of order', meaning order in my relationships with God, with other people and within myself. Where is there lack of peace in my life? Who do I need to make peace with? Do I make space to experience God's forgiveness and gift of peace? I ask for his peace so that I may bring others peace- '*Sacred Space' Irish Jesuits*

ST CLARE'S SVP CONFERENCE

Thank you all for your continuing contributions to the Foodbank. Last month St Clare's Church foodbank collection amounted to 47.7Kg. St Clare's congregation members including many SVP conference members volunteer at the Lache distribution centre in Hawthorn House at the end of Hawthorn Road on Friday lunch times. Last week we fed 40 people on 13

vouchers where a voucher represents a person or family. Lache distribution centre is run by the Trussell Trust West Cheshire Foodbank with its warehouse at Little Stanney in Ellesmere Port. Last week we ran out of desserts and gave families biscuits instead. The warehouse had no desserts to distribute and reports that food donations are similar to last year but demand is 25% higher hence the shortage.
