BISHOP MARK WRITES:

REOPENING OF PARISH PREMISES TO HIRERS/THIRD PARTIES,

"I have been advised that we should undertake this re-opening by a phased approach starting with parishes' long-standing contractual hirers, subject to current Government guidelines from 1st September.

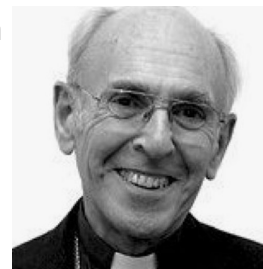
Before any group will be allowed to use parish premises, the parish buildings have to be prepared and the management of the parish halls/premises must undertake an appropriate risk assessment to ensure they are Covid-19 Secure, similar to the preparation undertaken to reopen our churches. In addition, all third-party users or hirers will be expected to provide the hall management with their written Covid-19 Secure arrangements".

We shall inform parishioners and the general public once we get through with the required process for reopening our Parish Room.
