UPDATE FROM THE BISHOPS CONFERENCE (OMICRON VARIANT)

It is important to ensure the following points are followed in our churches -That people displaying any symptoms of covid-19 should stay at home and not travel to church or participate in person.

-That hand sanitiser is available to those attending the Church.

-That there is a strong recommendation for people to wear a face covering (both nose and mouth) during the act of worship.

-That there is good ventilation and air throughput in the building; in this case, because of climatic conditions, it would be important to remind people to wrap up well in church! - That a positive message encouraging people to get vaccinated and have the booster jab when able is delivered whenever possible.
