SYNOD UPDATE: DIOCESAN LISTENING PHASE

The office of the bishop has released a final synthesis of contributions from around the Diocese and the required Episcopal Discernment from bishop Mark. The final document contains an 8-page synthesis of written contributions; a 2-page episcopal discernment. The synodal pathway now moves to the national and continental levels, as has been mapped out, in preparation for the International Synod of Bishops in October 2023.
