## **ROSARY CORNER**

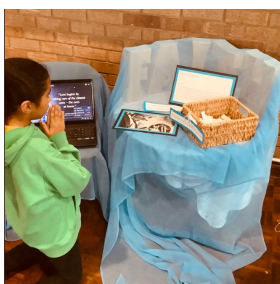
