ACCOUNTS FOR YEAR END MARCH 2024: The Finance Committee recently met for Paula to present the year end accounts (April 2023 - March 2024) which have now been submitted to the Diocese.

Income: £36,109 - which includes £27,746 received from standing orders, envelopes & loose plate.

Expenditure: £51,380 - The most significant expenditure include: additional carpet for the back of church, safety additions to choir loft stairs, new votive candle system, new altar missal and altar robes. Generalised increases include electricity, gas, insurance, council tax & water rates.

Excess of expenditure over income = £15,271
