THE POPE'S INTENTIONS FOR JANUARY 2025: For the right to an education. Let us pray for migrants, refugees and those affected by war, that their right to an education, which is necessary to build a better world, might always be respected.

POPE FRANCIS 'THROWS OPEN' HOLY DOOR TO INAUGURATE 2025 JUBILEE: On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica and officially inaugurated the 2025 Jubilee of Hope. The Pope said "During the Holy Year, may the light of Christian hope illumine every man and woman, as a message of God's love addressed to all! And may this Jubilee strengthen us in our faith, helping us to recognise the Risen Christ in the midst of our lives, transforming us into pilgrims of Christian hope."

THE HOLY LAND COORDINATION: A pilgrimage of 12 Bishops who will travel to Jerusalem from 18-23 January 2025. They are going to be present to the Christians who remain in the Holy Land, to let them know they are not forgotten; to pray with them; to encourage pilgrimage to their land; and to advocate on their behalf. Bishop Nicholas Hudson, the Chair of the Dept for International Affairs and Moderator of the Holy Land Coordination asks us to pray:

"Heavenly Father, we pray for all who suffer in the Land which your Son made Holy by his birth and life and dying and rising for us. May the Lord Jesus hold them in his Sacred Heart. Send forth again your Spirit to renew the face of the Holy Land and guide its people into the ways of peace and truth and reconciliation. We make this prayer through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen."
